

Wartrace MusicFest First Annual 5K Run / Walk in Memory of Amanda Floyd

WHAT IT IS: An added attraction to the 13th annual June 3rd Wartrace Music Fest is a memorial 5K Run/Walk dedicated to the memory of Amanda Floyd. Amanda was a beloved Wartrace native whose passion was long distance running. She died in 2013 at the age of 53 leaving four children and six grandchildren. She earned a Master of Science degree in Health Information Systems and was employed at Viam Inc. in Manchester as a computer systems analyst. Amanda's favorite runs included the Tennessee State Park Running Tour, the Moon Pie 10 mile run in Bell Buckle; the Flying Monkey Marathon; the Oak Barrel half marathon, and the Nashville Country Music Marathon.

WHEN AND WHERE: The 5K will begin near the Wartrace MusicFest grounds on Higgins Road (intersection of Higgins and Highway 269) in Wartrace at 9:00 AM on June 3rd 2017.



Participants can register at www.Reg2Run.com. The fee is \$25. Late registrations can be made for \$30 from 8:00 to 8:45 AM the morning of the run at the starting point. Entrants will receive a runner's packet containing a T-shirt, a MusicFest pass, MusicFest program and other items. An award ceremony will be held at 10:00 AM with medals for men and women's' first, second, and third place showings. Showers will be available at the Wartrace Fire Hall for runners.

ALL RUNNERS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN A WAIVER. Children twelve and under may run free but a parent must sign a waiver for them. They will not get a tee shirt. Children twelve and older, \$25 or \$30, depending on when they register. They will get the packet with tee shirt.
